GUIDELINE FOR HOME CARE NURSING SERVICES

Introduction

Home Care Nursing Services is an institute which would provide basic minimum care for patients in their homes/residences.

Home Care Nursing Services or Institution:

1. Institution should have a qualified Nursing Officer full time
2. Institution should be guided by a qualified overlooking Medical Officer who could take the responsibility in patient care
3. Should prove a mechanism to cover the emergencies.
4. Should have adequate numbers of caretakers to supply the services in continuous basis (minimum of 10)
5. Should have competent communication system in order to communicate effectively with the caretakers from their destination of work.
6. Should provide either facilities, for transport or the cost
7. Should facilitate with a dress code

Caretakers

1. Should process a certificate from the Government approve training institute.
2. Should be able to prove their skills and knowledge
3. Should carry a basic tool kit which is required for minimum patient care such as Scissor, Forceps, Gloves, Bandages and Cotton Wool.....etc.
4. Should have access to competent communication system in order to communicable effectively with the institution.
5. Should wear a decent dress while on duty as prescribed by the institute.
